Giving Thanks for Jesus at Christmas



At Christmastime, when I think about the Baby Jesus, my mind and heart jump to the cross. The Baby of the manger is the Christ of the cross. That leads me to think of my commitment to our Wonderful Savior. He is so patient with me. Great examples of God's patience are found in His Word. Jesus walked by the Sea of Galilee, saw brothers, Peter and Andrew, fishing and said to them, "Follow Me, ..." (Matthew 4:18-20) The Bible says they "straightway" followed.

We can read of Peter's actions through the gospels. He became spokesman for the disciples. He confessed Jesus as "...the Christ, the Son of the Living God..." (Matt. 16:13-16); he went with Jesus up an high mountain to observe the transfiguration (Matt. 17:1-9); he walked on water to Jesus (Matt. 14:25-32); he told Jesus he would never deny Him (Matt. 26:31-35).

THEN, after Jesus' arrest, Peter denied Him three times (Matt. 26:69-75). Jesus still loved Peter and called him again to obedience. In John 21:15-19, after His resurrection, Jesus, as He talked with seven disciples along the seashore, asked Peter three times if he loved Him (how about that? Three times). Peter was hurt, but answered that he loved Jesus. Just as Jesus had said to Peter the first time, He said to him again, "Follow Me." The book of Acts tells us how Peter followed Jesus, healing and teaching in the name of Christ. From John 21:18 we glean that Peter brought glory to God even in his death.

This Christmas, please consider Christ's love for you and His call on your life. Your past failures do not determine your future with the Lord. He never gives up on us. He's always calling, "Follow Me."

We vacationed in the North Carolina mountains with Joseph and his family.





We spent Labor Day on Allatoona Lake with Caroline and her family
